N., + **1578**, oo **II 1578 Anna N. N.^{4.5.}** oo **III before 1589 Ursula Lippmann, the god blessed. Merten Lippmann daughter, guardian 1586 Hans Heinrich Thum⁶ (?)**

1548 enfeoffment of the brothers John and Thomas, of Thomas Rebentisch blessed posthumous. Sons with the Kretzscha [pub] in Königswalde, as the father blessed already received from the Grünhain monastery, with all equitiesJustices. Given in Meißen, 07/08/1548 [enfeoffed farm Dresden, fief 1548 - 1731].

Anewed enfeoffment of the two brothers in 1555 by Herzog August, whereat Hans Rebentisch is decreed to judge. [Enfeoffed farm Dresden, fief 1548 - 1731] Pays taxes together with his brother Adam in 1548 for 1 fief 21 pence at Michaelmas⁷.
